2024 Children's Summer Class Policies

Please read this section carefully before registering. There are no exceptions to these policies.

REGISTRATION

- Registrations are processed in the order they are received, on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Students are encouraged to register early because summer classes fill very quickly.
- · If a class is full, you will have the option of being placed on the waiting list.
- Enrollment cannot be confirmed until your registration is fully processed.
- After a course is filled, no additional students will be accepted.
- Class size is limited in every class, in all age groups.

The Museum reserves the right to cancel/amend courses that are undersubscribed and to determine the point at which a course is considered to be full.

GUIDELINES

• All children attending classes must be escorted to and from the classroom by their parent/guardian for each class meeting and signed in/out accordingly.

• Only registered participants may attend classes. Siblings and guests are not allowed in the classroom.

• Every student must be picked up by a parent or authorized caregiver no later than 15 minutes after the student's class ends. Neither the Museum nor its staff can be held responsible for students who are not picked up within this 15-minute window.

- No electronic devices, including cell phones, will be allowed in the classroom.
- In the event that you have a personal emergency and are unable to arrive on time, you must call the Museum at (361) 358-8615.

DISCIPLINE / DISMISSAL

• The Museum reserves the right to remove students from classes for behavior that is deemed to be rude, disruptive, inappropriate, dangerous or in violation of health and safety regulations.

• Individual instructors maintain the right to dismiss a student from a class with a warning, and to remove a student permanently from a class for repeated offenses.

ILLNESS

In order to protect the health of all students, students may not attend class when ill with a communicable disease or condition (COVID-19 or its symptoms, chicken pox, pink eye, strep throat, head lice, etc.). The Museum reserves the right to notify parents/guardians regarding a student who may become ill during class and to request that said student be picked up immediately. The Museum also reserves the right to request a physician's authorization for return to class.
