2024 Children's Summer Class Policies

Please read this section carefully before registering.
There are no exceptions to these policies.

REGISTRATION

- Registrations are processed in the order they are received, on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Students are encouraged to register early because summer classes fill very quickly.
- If a class is full, you will have the option of being placed on the waiting list.
- Enrollment cannot be confirmed until your registration is fully processed.
- After a course is filled, no additional students will be accepted.
- Class size is limited in every class, in all age groups.

The Museum reserves the right to cancel/amend courses that are undersubscribed and to determine the point at which a course is considered to be full.

GUIDELINES

- All children attending classes must be escorted to and from the classroom by their parent/guardian for each class meeting and signed in/out accordingly.
- Only registered participants may attend classes. Siblings and guests are not allowed in the classroom.
- Every student must be picked up by a parent or authorized caregiver no later than 15 minutes after the student's class ends. Neither the Museum nor its staff can be held responsible for students who are not picked up within this 15-minute window.
- No electronic devices, including cell phones, will be allowed in the classroom.
- In the event that you have a personal emergency and are unable to arrive on time, you must call the Museum at (361) 358-8615.

DISCIPLINE / DISMISSAL

- The Museum reserves the right to remove students from classes for behavior that is deemed to be rude, disruptive, inappropriate, dangerous or in violation of health and safety regulations.
- Individual instructors maintain the right to dismiss a student from a class with a warning, and to remove a student permanently from a class for repeated offenses.

ILLNESS

In order to protect the health of all students, students may not attend class when ill with a communicable disease or condition (COVID-19 or its symptoms, chicken pox, pink eye, strep throat, head lice, etc.). The Museum reserves the right to notify parents/guardians regarding a student who may become ill during class and to request that said student be picked up immediately. The Museum also reserves the right to request a physician's authorization for return to class.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the behavior expectations for art class participants?

- Art students are expected to:
- listen and follow instructions
 - participate in class activities
 - respect others
 - respect property
 - have fun!

A friend or relative is visiting from out of town. May he/she attend class as a guest with my child?

No. Only registered participants may attend class. Guests are not allowed in the classroom.

May I stay in the classroom with my child?

No. If you feel that your child is unable to remain in the classroom

for more than a few minutes without you, wait another summer before sending him/her to art class. Independent learning and socialization are part of the art camp experience.

What should my child wear to art class?

Comfortable clothes that can get messy.

The class my child wants to take is full. Is there anything I can do to get him/her in this class?

After a class has reached the maximum enrollment, no additional students may register. There is a waiting list and these students are called in order received, if space becomes available.

HOLDING OF ARTWORK

The Beeville Art Museum will display the artwork created by the participants of our summer art camps in the Museum's Children Exhibit. The opening reception for the exhibition will be the first Saturday in August. We encourage all to attend. An invitation will be mailed to each participant and/or their families prior to the exhibit.

PICK UP OF ARTWORK

Artwork displayed in the Children's Exhibit may be picked up September 3rd -30th. As of October 1st, all artwork becomes the property of the Beeville Art Museum.
